With the cast of 60 Days In having to effectively give up their liberty and put themselves in danger, Netflix viewers have been left wondering whether the volunteers get financially reimbursed for their time on the show. One user of the 60 Days In Reddit has made an estimation about how much participants might be paid. They wrote: "I used to work in reality TV and A&E budgets for 1-hour show are typically around \$375,000 per episode. this does seem consistent with what we know about how much reality show contestants get paid.

On American Idol, for example, contestants are made to join the AFTRA (American) Tj T* BT

minimum rate of \$1,571 plus meals for the then two-hour Idol shows, \$1,303 for one-hour shows and \$910 for half-hour results shows as of October 2018. US Weekly also reported that newbie contestants on MTV's The Challenge make \$1,000 per week.

Though we do not know exactly how much 60 Days In participants are paid, we do know that the A&E show also pays money to the prison to film there. For example, the show paid \$60,000 to the Clark County jail for filming there over 120 days-about \$500 per day. The jail's sheriff Jamey Noel said to Indiana's News and Tribune that the money, "will go to training and equipment actually for the jail."
